- Population of 45 million inhabitants
- 50% young people
- 83.35% living in rural areas
- 71.9% economy depends on agriculture
- 4.4% industry
- 23.7 service
- Ugandans averagely live below 2.5 USD per day
- Average Monthly household income is 133.3 USD

Volunteer centers

- Variety of volunteer centers in Uganda unfortunately luck statistics on the number of volunteer centers due to luck of a major volunteer body to over look or organise volunteer centers
- There are many volunteers coming in on institutional levels, private and individual levels working in various regions, others are social tourists

Volunteer ages

- Most volunteers working in Uganda are between age 18 to 45 average best to fit in the social environment in Uganda
- Most are university students or interns
- The focus is always on young people because the country depends on their future

The fun of volunteering in uganda

- Uganda is ranked as one of the most friendly nations in the world
- People are very social and making friends is just as easy as counting 1 to 10.
- Right from the airport you will see smiling faces and waving at you with words like Mzungu(meaning white person) logically interpreted as moving around.
- All times people will engage you about where you cone from, touch your skin
- Dont hesistate to ask for directions when lost, people will be willing to direct you
 upto your destination free of charge
- The food is organic straight from the garden however clean drinking water is expensive since its only bottled.
- Rich culture with over 360 cultures and languages with different dress codes makes it a place to explore during your voluntary work.

Cons or bad side of volunteer in Uganda

- Feeling that you have not made any impact due to so many unsolved and endless problems in communities
- Ugandan time, if you are one who likes working on schedule you just have to slow down your challenges (there is no hurry in African) 9am means 10 or 11 am.
- Mosquitoes and lots of contagious diseases so you need to arrange your first Aid box
- Politics leading to instabilities
- Electricity, constant long hours power cut and water supply

Areas of volunteering in uganda

- Education/youth development. With 50% of population under age of 15, mist areas of volunteering is needed more with the children especially in schools, orphanages and other child centers
- Health, Uganda has been one of the rare stories of HIV/AIDS in Africa,
 Malaria ranking so high therefore needs of awareness is Paramount.
- Community and economic development especially WASH systems, adult education, income generating skills training
- Agriculture, improved skills away from subsistence production to commercial value addition farming
- Conservation, climate change challenges like importance of planting trees, proms of pollution, bad fishing habits, wild hunting of rare species
