When one-third of non-profit organizations face a danger of being shut down (McCartney, 2020), how a social enterprise like this is going to survive?




- > less able to realize charitable projects

Object: the cat-cafés


Subject: practices enhancing the café's resilience

Resilience




capacities to prevent, survive, recover from and learn from the impact of natural or human-made disasters, as well as to adapt to changes (Roundy et al. 2017).





Adopting and developing Internet marketing tools and social networks


Governance
