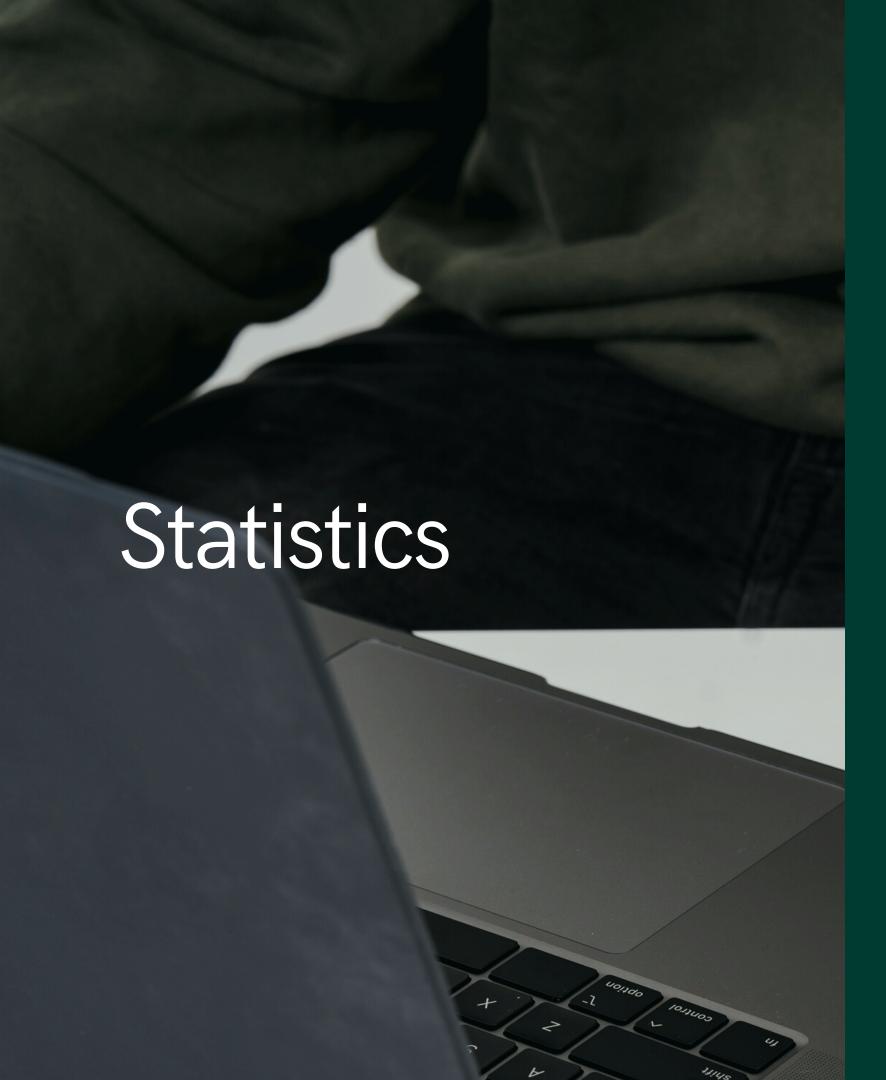
THE GOAL OF THE PAPER:
